academic goals by providing personalised support, guidance and instruction. You will also be supporting recruitment for the next academic year and maintaining strong relationships with the schools and Community

Trust we support.

A Post-16 Tutor will have the knowledge and experience of providing education and motivate the students by setting realistic goals, offering encouragement and connecting sport skills to academic success.



ROLE SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

Main Duties and Responsibilities

- As the Lead Tutor for Post-16 Education, you will provide a first-class education programme for learners enrolled on the BTEC & NCFE provisions offered by the Community Trust.
- You will also support the department with ideas for growth and the recruitment of new learners for future cohorts.
- In the role, you will be able to provide strong leadership for your learners and ensure the delivery of a high-quality provision across the programme to support academic development of the learners enrolled at Mansfield Town Community Trust Sports College.
- As per the agreement laid out by the LFE (League Football Education), Tutors will utilise the EMS System, on which they will conduct assessment on learner work in a 10-day window, following submission.
- Report to the Head of Education and your Designated Safeguarding Lead all concerns you have regarding any learners enrolled on the provision, at your nearest convenience.





ROLE SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

Behaviour and Conduct
